**Rules & Regulations for Entrants to
Ayrshire VTMC Rally at Whitefordhill Agri-Centre, Ayr, KA6 5JW
on Sunday 19 July 2020**

1. Entries to be returned together with entry fee of **£3.00 per exhibitor** to address below no later than **Friday 5 June 2020**. Please make cheques payable to **A.V.T.M.C.**
2. One plaque per exhibitor will be issued only if entry fee is paid.
3. **Late entries may be accepted but will not be listed in the catalogue** and may not receive a plaque.
4. All Entries will be acknowledged and will receive a rally information pack. Acknowledgements will commence after the closing date.
5. Exhibits may be entered into the field any time on Saturday. Overnight caravans may enter the field on Saturday, only if notified on entry form.
6. **In the interest of safety, all exhibits must be in place in the field by 10.00am on the morning of the Rally to avoid being refused entry.**
7. All drivers should be standing by their vehicles ready for the parade at the time indicated. No vehicle can enter the parade if not properly manned at the correct time.
8. All drivers must be properly licensed for the class of vehicles which they are driving.
9. All exhibitors must ensure that their vehicles are properly licensed, insured and taxed to meet current legal requirements.
10. No stationary engines are to be left running unattended.
11. **In the interest of safety, Exhibitors must not move any exhibits from their stance before 4.00pm unless they are instructed to by a Marshal.**
12. **IMPORTANT:** Subject to favourable ground conditions, Vehicles transporting Tractors to the Rally and arriving on the Saturday are invited to park in a designated area in the Rally Field. Vehicles transporting Tractors to the Rally and arriving on the Sunday, will be required to park at the Market Yard unload there, and drive the Tractors to the Rally Field.
